i. NBPL will no longer issue refunds for materials returned following payment of replacement cost. If a patron finds material that they considered lost that they had already paid for, they are welcome to keep the item or donate it back to the library.

ii. New Loan Rule: Non-holdable items. We've only used this for our Wi-Fi hotspots as we are having issues with them being returned. While we can't restrict use of library materials to residents only, can make items in our collection local pick up only.

iii. Added newer items in our collection to our Loan Rule table (Tonies, videogames)

Chair Frandsen made a motion to approve the Circulation Policy with the revisions listed above, seconded by Chairperson Anderson.
